

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## CHAIRMAN'S REPORT TUAIRISC AN CHATHAOIRLIGH

*T*he year under review posed many challenges to the institution, not least how to mark one hundred and fifty years of service and achievement. Whilst celebration of the past was central to what was managed over the period, there was also much energy applied to providing for the future. The Board is especially appreciative of the support of the Department of Arts, Sport and Tourism during the course of its sesquicentenary celebrations.

At the heart of such celebrations was the development of the collection. Visitors to the institution today are constantly amazed at the range and quality of what is on display. Accumulated over the past one hundred and fifty years, it stands as a testament to the wisdom, taste and generosity of preceding generations of Irish art lovers. In looking to acknowledge what has been achieved by past generations and mark the sesquicentenary by a gesture of substance by the current generation, consideration was given to establishing a special anniversary fund to enhance the collection, a fund which would highlight the contribution of those instrumental in its foundation. To this end a strategy was put in place to establish a body of benefactors committed to the acquisition of works for the collection. This body would bear the name The Dargan Council, referring in particular to the role of William Dargan in establishing the Gallery, and his personal contribution to the funding of acquisitions during its earliest years.

The institution is fortunate not only in that its founding fathers saw the importance of establishing a public collection but saw fit to house it on a prime site in the heart of the capital, easily accessible to all. It is the responsibility of the current Board to ensure that the handsome complex of buildings of Merrion Square has the capacity to service the growing collection and its

Cé go raibh ceiliúradh ar an am atá caite lárnach dá mbainistíodh i rith na tréimhse, cuireadh go leor fuinnimh isteach i bphóráil don todhchaí. Tá an Bord fior-bhuíoch as tacaíocht na Roinne Ealaíon, Spóirt agus Turasóireachta i gcaitheamh a cheiliúrthaí céad go leith bliana.

Ag croí na gceiliúrthaí sin bhí forbairt an bhailíúcháin. Tagann ionadh ar chuairteoirí chuig an institiúid i gcónaí roimh raon agus cáilíocht an ábhair a bhíonn ar taispeáint. Agus é carntha le céad caoga bliain anuas, seasann sé mar thiomna do ghaois, breithiúnas agus flaithiúlacht na nglúnta roimhe sin ar mhór leo ealaín na hÉireann. Tugadh machnamh do bhunú chiste comórtha faoi leith leis an mbailiúchán a fheabhsú nuair a bhíothas ag féachaint le haitheantas a thabhairt dár bhain na glúnta romhainne amach agus ag iarraidh céad go leith bliain a chomóradh le beart nach beag ón nglúin reatha. Is ciste é seo lena gcuirfi béim ar rannchur na ndaoine siúd a bhí páirteach i mbunú an Ghailearáí fén. Ba chuiige sin a cuireadh straitéis ar bun chun roinnt deontóirí a bhunú a bheadh tiomanta do shealbhú éadálacha don bhailiúchán. Thabharfaí Comhairle Dargan ar an gcomhlacht seo, ag tagairt ach go háirithe do ról William Dargan i mbunú an Ghailearáí, lena rannchur pearsanta do mhaoiniú éadálacha le linn a bhlianta tosaigh.

Ní hamháin go bhfuil an t-ádh ar an bhforas go bhfacthas dá bhunaitheoirí an tábhacht a bhain le bunú bailiúcháin phoiblí, ach d'fhéach siad lena chur ar shuíomh dearscnaitheach i gcroílár na príomhchathrach, le rochtain flusa ag cách air. Is í freagrácht an Bhoird reatha a chinntíú go mbíonn an cumas ag an ngrúpa breá d'fhoirgneamh i

public into the future. With a view to realising this requirement, much time was given to considering the details of the Master Development Plan and how it could be implemented to the best advantage of the Gallery, including the need to make optimum use of its limited footprint in the heart of Georgian Dublin. The progress achieved over the past year will do much to enhance the merits of the project, the initial phases of which are scheduled to go to tender in 2005. With the support of the Office of Public Works, the refurbishment of No. 5 South Leinster Street will be the first element of the project to commence with work on site scheduled to begin next year, with completion due in late 2006/2007.

A particularly enjoyable element of the year's proceedings was the wonderful Gala Banquet held in early November which provided the opportunity to entertain a host of special guests, including Government Minister for Education and Science, Mary Hanafin TD, senior Department officials, former Board members, together with benefactors and other supporters who had contributed to the cultural life of the nation. In this respect it is appropriate to recognise the contribution of the media in highlighting the activities of the Gallery over the past twelve months, joining in the celebrations and giving fulsome coverage to the very ambitious and ultimately very successful programme of events.

The pressures and demands of the anniversary programme placed a considerable burden of expectation on the Director and staff of the Gallery. Whilst much was expected, there were no guarantees, and as always, funding was tight. Yet they succeeded in delivering a series of international exhibitions, special events and ancillary

Ba chuid sách taitneamhach de na himeachtaí imbliana é an fhleá mhór iontach a reáchtáladh go luath i mí na Samhna, a bhí mar dheis chun slua mór d'aíonna faoi leith a óstú, lenar áiríodh Aire Oideachais agus Eolaíochta an Rialtais, Mary Hanafin TD, oifigigh shinsearacha na Roinne, iarthromhaltaí den Bhord, in éineacht le deontóirí agus lucht tacaíochta eile a chuir le saol cultúrtha an náisiúin. Is ceart aitheantas a thabhairt ina leith sin do rannchur lucht na meán chun gníomhaíochtaí an Ghailearaí a léiriú le dhá mhí dhéag anuas, agus iad ag glacadh páirte sa cheiliúradh agus ag tabhairt cumhdaigh nach beag don chlár fíor-uaillmhianach imeachtaí, clár ar éirigh go mór leis ar deireadh thiar.

Chuir brúnna agus éilimh chlár an cheiliúrtha ualach mór ionchais ar Stiúrthóir agus ar fhoireann an Ghailearaí fén. Cé go rabhthas ag dúil leis an iomad, ní raibh aon ráthú ann, agus bhí an maoiniú gann mar a bhí riamh anall. In the area of Corporate Governance, I am pleased to advise that the recommendations contained in the Report of the Working Group on Accountability of Secretaries General and Accounting Officers ('The Mullarkey Report') are substantially complete and in full accordance with the timescales included. This work is being monitored through the Audit and Risk Committee of the Board. In relation to Risk Management, a full review of risks was carried out in 2004 to ensure the validity and effectiveness of the process.

## DIRECTOR'S REVIEW TUAIRISC AN STIÚRTHÓRA

*C*oinciding with Ireland's presidency of the EU, the Gallery's sesquicentenary year was a memorable one, marked by a series of exceptional events. Building on the achievement of one hundred and fifty years since its foundation in August 1854, the celebrations worked to promote awareness of the institution in the community, working with the media to inform and excite interest in the collection, its history and relevance, with a particular emphasis on promoting accessibility. In tandem with this advocacy of the Gallery's role in Irish society, considerable energy and resources were allocated to delivering a service which would lend substance to the promises of a memorable anniversary year. Key features of the programme were an ambitious sequence of international exhibitions, special talks, music recitals and publications.

### Exhibitions

It is only in relatively recent times that the Gallery has had the capacity to mount major exhibitions and only very recently that it has been in a position to promote major international shows. Among the more ambitious undertakings during the year was the exhibitions programme, which featured three major inter-

*C*uimhneofar go ceann i bhfad ar an gcaogú bliain is céad den Ghailearaí, agus í ag comhtharlú le huachtaráinacht na hÉireann ar an AE; agus reáchtáladh sraith imeachtaí eisceachtúla mar chomhartha dó sin. Ag tógál ar ghnóthachan chéad caoga bliain óna bhunú i Lúnasa na bliana 1854, d'fheidhmigh an ceiliúradh le feasacht a spreagadh faoin institiúid i measc an phobail; ag obair i gcomhar leis na meáin chun spéis a mhúnlú agus ghríosú sa bhailiúchán, ina stair agus ina ábharthacht, le béim faoi leith ar chur chun cinn na hinrochtaineachta. I gcomhar le habhcóideacht ról an Ghailearaí i sochaí na hÉireann, leithdháileadh go leor acmhainní do sheachadadh seirbhísé a thabharfadhl brí do gheallúintí na bliana comórtha seo, bliain a mhairfidh go fada sa chuimhne. Príomhgnéithe den chlár ab ea seicheamh uaillmhianach de thaispeántais idirnáisiúnta, cainteanna speisialta, ceadail cheoil agus foilseacháin.

### Taispeántais

Is le scaitheamh beag anuas a bhí sé ar chumas an Ghailearaí taispeántais mhóra a reáchtáil, agus ní ach le rí-ghairid anuas arbh fhéidir leis seónna móra idirnáisiúnta a chur chun cinn. national shows complemented by a series of domestic 'in-focus' presentations supplemented by a series of special displays in the Print Gallery. To mark Ireland's presidency of the EU and in particular to welcome the ten new accession states, the exhibitions department mounted a unique show, *New Frontiers*, which highlighted the art of the new member nations. On display were sixty works covering a range of styles and subject matter, mostly dating to the early twentieth century, reflecting aspects of European culture stretching from the Baltic to the Mediterranean. In achieving this extraordinary spectacle the Gallery acknowledges its debt to the participating institutions who so promptly and generously offered their cooperation. We look forward to further collaboration with our new EU colleagues in the future.

The Exhibitions Department mounted two other exceptional shows; in summer, a display devoted to the work of the great eighteenth-century Spanish still-life painter, Luis Meléndez, and in the autumn a presentation of German romantic painting from Berlin. Organised with the support of the Spanish Embassy in Dublin the Meléndez show had at its heart the fabulous holding of the artist's work housed in the Prado Museum, which worked closely with the Gallery, having just mounted a similar event in Madrid. *A German Dream: Masterpieces of Romanticism from the Nationalgalerie Berlin*, was achieved with the generous support of the Staatliche Museen zu Berlin. The fifty-nine works on view, which included five compositions by Caspar David Friedrich, the most celebrated artist of the period, were all drawn from the Nationalgalerie's own superb collection and provided the Irish public with a unique opportunity to relish some of the most remarkable creations of nineteenth-century German visual culture.

Mar chomhartha ar uachtará-nacht na hÉireann ar an AE, agus go háirithe le fáilte a chur roimh na deich mballstáit úra aontaithe, ab ea a reáchtáil rannóg na dtaispeántas seo uathúil, *New Frontiers*, inar léiríodh ealaín na mball-náisiún úr. Bhí seasca saothar ar taispeáint ann, ag clúdach raon stíleanna agus ábhar, ag teacht ó luath sa fichiú haois, ag léiriú tréithe de chultúr na hEorpa ón Muir Bhailt go dtí an Mheánmhuir. Aithníonn an Gailearaí a fhiach do na forais rannpháirteacha a thairg a gcomhoibriú go pras agus go flaithiúil chun an léiriúchán neamhghnách sin a bhaint amach. Táimid ag dúil lena thuilleadh comhoibrithe lenár gcomhghleacaithe úra san AE amach anseo.

Reáchtáil Rannóg na dtaispeántas dhá sheó eisceachtúla eile; taispeántas sa samhradh do shaothar phéintéir Spáinneach neamhbheo mór ón ochtú haois, Luis Meléndez, agus léiriúchán san fhómhar de phéintéireacht rómánsúil Ghearmánach ó Bheirlín. Arna eagrú le tacaíocht Ambasáid na Spáinne i mBaile Átha Cliath; bhí cnuasach iontach de shaothar an ealaíontóra ó Mhúsaem Prado, agus d'oirbriugh siad go dlúth leis an nGailearái díreach tar éis dóibh imeacht den chineál céanna a reáchtáil thall i Madrid. *A German Dream: Masterpieces of Romanticism from the Nationalgalerie Berlin*; taispeántas a rinneadh le tacaíocht fhlaithiúil ón Staatliche Museen zu Berlin. In February, a special display of masterpieces were placed in the care of the Gallery from the Dublin City Gallery, The Hugh Lane to accommodate their major works programme to include the construction of a new wing to be opened early in 2006. Among the works on view were nineteenth and twentieth century Irish and British paintings from the Lane Bequest including French masterpieces by Renoir, Manet and Degas. The loan was facilitated by agreement with the Dublin City Gallery and the National Gallery, London.

Over the summer, to mark the Gallery's anniversary, the Prints and Drawings Department mounted an exhibition which focused on the history and development of the institution. Drawing on its holding of original architects' drawings and material made available from the archive, including manuscript material and period photographs, *A plain structure firmly built* presented a fascinating survey relating the origins of the institution and its constantly evolving face over a period of 150 years of history.

### Collection

The collection of the National Gallery of Ireland today must surely exceed even the most optimistic expectations of its founding members, who just a few years after the Great Famine, with a remarkable generosity of spirit, set about campaigning to establish a public picture collection in the nation's capital. Yet miraculously, from what could only be deemed an inauspicious start, they set about building a collection from scratch with limited financial means but with a wealth of ambition. By way of a combination of good fortune and perspicacity some remarkable pieces were acquired for very modest sums, among them a series of significant pieces purchased in the brief space of four years; a Poussin (1882, £503), a Rembrandt (1883, £514)

Le bheith mar chomhartha ar chéad caoga bliain den Ghailearaí ab ea a réachtáil Rannóg na bPriontaí agus na Líníochtaí taispeántas i rith an tsamhraidh a dhírigh ar stair agus forbairt an fhoraí. Ag tarraingt ar a choinneáil de bhunlíníochtaí agus bunábhar na n-aitírí a cuireadh ar fáil ón gcartlann, lena n-áirítear ábhar lámhscríbhinn agus grianghraif ón tréimhse, chuir *A plain structure firmly built* i láthair suirbhé inspéise maidir le bunús an fhoraí agus a éadan síor-athraitheach thar thréimhse 150 bliain staire.

### Bailiúchán

Caithfidh sé a bheith amhlaidh go sáraíonn bailiúchán Ghailearaí Náisiúnta na hÉireann fiú amháin na hionchais ba shoirbhíche dá bhunaitheoirí, a chuaigh i mbun feachtas gan ach cúpla bliain gairid tar éis an Ghorta Mhóir, le flaithiúlacht nótáilte, chun bailiúchán pictiúr poiblí a bhunú i bpríomhchathair na tíre. Ba mhíorúilteach an beart é nuair a chuaigh siad i mbun bailiúchán a thógáil ón mbonn aníos, tar éis tosach fíor-mhíshéanmhar, le ganntanas acmhainní airgeadais ach le flúirseach uaillmhéine. Ba thrí chumasc d'ámharaí an tsaoil agus an ghéarchúis a fuarthas saothair iomráiteacha ar rí-bheagán airgid, ina measc sraith de shaothair shuntasacha a ceannaíodh in imeacht cheithre bliana;

a Titian (1885, £70.18.00) and a Fra Angelico (1886, £73.10.00).

In 2004, the Gallery was fortunate to make a number of notable additions to what has become a richly varied collection. In this instance the artists involved were mostly Irish and the prices were substantially greater. A particularly welcome addition was the composition, *A Wooded River Landscape* by George Barret, acquired at auction for the sum of €300,000. Among the most accomplished landscape artists of his generation, Barret was to date represented in the permanent display by just one major work, *A View of Powerscourt Waterfall*, acquired in 1880 for £23.10.00. Also acquired at auction was Paul

Henry's, *A Connemara Village*, a large-scale composition which greatly enhances the Gallery's presentation of work by Ireland's best-loved landscape painter of the 20th century. Another notable addition was a wonderful crepuscular Liffey-side scene, *The Dublin Streets: A Vendor of Books*, by Walter Osborne, bequeathed to the Gallery by John Hamilton-Hunter. Other notable acquisitions were *The return of the goats*, John Lavery's contribution to the Paris Salon (1884) and *Fish Still Life* by William Scott. Also secured for the collection were sixty-three cartoons by Jack B. Yeats which the artist secretly supplied to Punch Magazine under the nom de plume of *William Bird*.

It is intended that this system will service the needs of most departments with respect to their administration requirements in dealing with the collection over the coming years

### **Conservation**

Throughout the year, the Conservation Department attended the inspection and treatment of the collection and loans, in addition to monitoring conditions within the complex of buildings on Merrion Square. A significant development in the department was the commissioning of the new Paper Conservation Studio located in the Milltown Wing, transferring from No.88 Merrion Square. The new facility, fitted out by the Office of Public Works, delivers a more secure, efficient, customised environment in which to manage the treatment of works on paper, by far the largest single constituent element within the collection (some 10,000 pieces). During the latter part of the year, an intriguing discovery was made when work on a number of sheets by Paul Henry led to the uncovering of a new version of his charcoal composition illustrating Davidson's *The Ballad of a Nun*.

### **Education**

As always, the Education Department ran a busy schedule of programmes and events during the year, working at various levels to engage the interest of all elements of the community. Among the highlights of the period under review was the *Learning from Art* project, the culmination of a six-year exercise involving primary and post-primary schools drawn from every county in Ireland, North and South. Over the preceding years the department liaised with schools, inviting their students to

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come and view the collection and then document their response to the experience by way of drawing, painting, and writing. The end product was a presentation of 40 exhibits which went on display at the Gallery in September and later went on tour around the country. Further engagement with communities around the country was managed by way of the Department's outreach programme, which over the year, hosted some 250 events nationwide. As a contribution to the Gallery's sesquicentenary programme the department, in collaboration with the Curatorial Department, organised a special series of lectures, *The Story of the Great Masters*, inviting internationally renowned scholars to come to Dublin to talk on key works in the collection.

### Anniversary Programme

The first public event specifically associated with the 150th anniversary celebrations was the special edition of *Rattlebag* on RTÉ Radio 1, which was transmitted live on 9 March from the Shaw Room. Hosted by Sean Rocks before a live audience, the programme combined interviews with staff about the day-to-day operations of the institution together with material from RTÉ's own archive featuring former Director James White, as well as a telephone interview with his successor, Homan Potterton. It was followed on 29 March by a television programme for RTÉ *Nationwide* presented by Laura Fletcher on the history and achievements of the Gallery, through a series of interviews and footage of the collection and its services.

On 10 August, a commemorative day of celebration was organised to coincide with the establishment of the Gallery by Act of Parliament on that same date in 1854. To mark the occasion a

special supplement was printed in The Irish Times, incorporating editorial on all aspects of the Gallery's public programme, its collection and services. Among the events arranged for the day was an open invitation to the public to come and enjoy a free afternoon treat in the Gallery restaurant, an invitation which was taken up by the hundreds of admiring guests who queued patiently before rapidly going through the assorted fare prepared for their enjoyment.

Over a six-week period during the summer (3 June-12 August) the highly acclaimed National Chamber Choir contributed to the celebrations by way of a series of recitals comprising specially commissioned pieces by international composers, each work inspired by a painting in the collection. Compositions were devoted to Caravaggio, *The Taking of Christ*; Eugène Delacroix, *Demosthenes on the Seashore*; Richard Wilson, *The Temple of the Sibyl, Tivoli*; Francisco de Zurbarán, *Inmaculada Concepción*; Karel Dujardin, *The Riding School*, and a series of paintings by Jack B. Yeats. Conducted by Celso Antunes, Bo Holten and Daniel Reuss, the recitals drew exceptional performances from the choir, which ranged from classically inspired compositions to works of challenging modernity. The recitals were broadcast by RTÉ Lyric FM. Following the final performance, a commemora-

On the afternoon of Saturday 6 November, Robert Hughes, the internationally renowned art critic and writer, gave a talk to a packed audience in the Baroque Gallery. Over four hundred people were in attendance to hear Hughes, a larger than life figure present with a wonderful baritone delivery, his views on the role of a national gallery and how it should manage its collections and serve its public. The talk was recorded live by RTÉ Radio 1, and later broadcast to a national audience at the end of December.

Also broadcast, was *Moving Pictures*, a unique contribution to the anniversary schedule, commissioned by RTÉ and launched by the Minister for Arts, Sport and Tourism. This television programme was made up of three separate elements, a vox pop consideration of the role of the gallery in the life of the typical visitor, together with a sequence of contributions by artist Noel Sheridan, who toured the collection commenting on particular works and their special meaning for him, as well as a studio discussion chaired by John Kelly. The cleverly edited contributions from visitors, recorded at the Gallery during the month of November, captured a very real sense of engagement with and affection for the institution, illustrating how the Gallery had

The final element in the sesquicentenary celebrations was the Gala Banquet held on 6 November in the sumptuous surrounds of the Shaw Room. Over two hundred guests were in attendance, made up of current and former board members, benefactors and staff. A notable and welcome guest on the evening was the writer and historian, Peter Somerville-Large, who over the preceding three years had been engaged in researching the history of the Gallery. Invitees to the banquet each received a copy of the newly published *1854-2004 The Story of the National Gallery of Ireland*, a handsomely illustrated volume which for generations to come will be the standard reference for all those interested in how the institution came to be established and its subsequent development down to the present day.

The Development and Press Office were heavily involved in the planning and servicing of all the special events associated with the sesquicentenary celebrations. It was a particularly ambitious programme which made great demands on all participants. Funding was especially critical and placed considerable strain on the Gallery's modest resources yet the twelve-month commitment was achieved with great resourcefulness and without compromising the institution's financial integrity. In addition to achieving the specific goals of each separate element in the programme, the overall

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result greatly increased the public profile for the Gallery, promoting its role in the life of the nation, delivering on the expectations of its founders all of 150 years ago.

### **Publications**

The specially commissioned history of the Gallery was the major publication produced by the Gallery Shop which experienced fluctuating fortunes during the year. Despite the closure of the satellite shop, and a difficult trading year, the shop managed to remain profitable through effective management and cost control. A noteworthy success was the well-merited first prize awarded in the museums category for the 2004 '*Seasons*' calendar at the business calendar awards presented in London.

### **Research Services**

The Library & Research Services which includes the CSIA (Centre for the Study of Irish Art) committed a lot of its energies to coming to grips with the new computer cataloguing system acquired the previous year to manage the book stock. In addition, plans were set in place to secure a system to deal with archives and especially material stored in the CSIA.

### **Building**

Management of the building complex adjacent to Leinster House focused on the delivery of the new Paper Conservation Studio and the upgrading of No.90 Merrion Square, the latter a major undertaking necessitated by the requirement to improve the floor loading in addition to decorative improvements. Significant progress was made with the preparation of plans for the refurbishment of No. 5 South Leinster Street, and it is intended to commence work on this project in 2005. Consideration was also given to the recycling of

### Friends

The highlights of the Friends were the two trips abroad to Madrid and Berlin where members were introduced to the attractions of two of Europe's most important cultural centres. Music, as ever, played a part in the programming of the Friends, most notably a special performance on 7 February presented by Peter Sargent, son of the legendary musician, Sir Malcolm Sargent, as well as the annual outing to the Wexford Festival Opera in October. Throughout the year, Friends were treated to a varied programme, ranging from talks and tours to visits to local centres of historic and cultural significance.

### Administration

As always, the Administration Department facilitated the effective delivery of our public services in a manner to which we have now become accustomed. In particular, the department's contribution towards best practice in corporate governance has been significant. Its support in staff recruitment and development, financial reporting and control, and the provision of first class IT services is much appreciated. Visitor numbers for the year were just over 770,000.


#### New Frontiers-art from new EU member states

3 March – 30 May

As the European Union welcomed ten new member states during Ireland's presidency of the EU, the National Gallery of Ireland marked this special occasion with an exhibition of 57 works from the national galleries in each of the ten accessioning countries (Cyprus, Czech Republic, Estonia, Hungary, Latvia, Lithuania, Malta, Poland, Slovak Republic and Slovenia). Working closely with the respective national galleries, the Gallery requested 4–6 works dating from 1850–1950 from each of the ten states – works that they considered would best represent their national heritage and its European dimension – as well as an essay and entries to accompany each exhibit. The exhibition catalogue included an introductory essay by Steven A. Mansbach, Professor of the History of Modern Art, University of Maryland, as well as contributing essays from the museum directors of each of the national institutions.

#### Luis Meléndez-Still Lifes

16 June – 5 September

This substantial presentation of masterpieces by Meléndez contributed to a better awareness and understanding of the artist, who was born in Naples in 1716 to a Spanish family and spent virtually his entire working life in Spain. In examining the extensive array of still-lifes on view visitors were afforded a unique opportunity to consider his extraordinary achievement and assess his development, placing him in his time and highlighting particular aspects of his personality and inspiration, noting his possible encounters, directly or indirectly with other artists. This exhibition was organised by the Museo Nacional del Prado and the Dublin showing was the most important presentation of the master's work outside Spain. Dr Peter Cherry of Trinity College, Dublin co-wrote the accompanying catalogue together with Dr Juan José Luna, Curator of Eighteenth-Century Painting in the Prado.





## EDUCATION OIDEACHAS

The major event for the Education Department was the coming to fruition after six years of the project, *Learning from Art*. It comprised an exhibition of the work of young people from primary and post-primary schools in 32 counties, created between 1999–2003, accompanied by a catalogue with essays written by a variety of artists, writers and arts practitioners associated with the Gallery (a copy of which was distributed to every school in the country). This project was important because it brought young people in close contact with an individual work in the collection, to which they were invited to form their own response in poetry, prose and art. Through the assistance of staff, guides and outreach tutors, they learnt a great deal about art appreciation and the collection, the practical aspects of drawing and painting, and the concept of art and creativity. Receptions held on 21 September marked the event; for the young exhibitors, their families and teachers, the second marked the opening of the exhibition by Pauline Bewick RHA at which Gallery guests and invitees of the sponsors, Esso Ireland and the Department of Education and Science attended, and a dinner for those involved in the catalogue. The exhibition began its 2004 touring schedule to St. Patrick's College/DCU and Glor, Ennis. The Education Department was a major participant in the Gallery's anniversary celebrations which comprised the Open Day on 10 August; *The Story of the Great Masters* lecture series, the 2004 Lecture: 'A Nation's Self-Image in an Art Museum' given by international art critic, writer and historian: Robert Hughes, attended by 400 people.

The Schools Programme performed on all fronts. Teenager's study revision days held in Cork, Dundalk and Athlone proved extremely successful and will be expanded in 2005.

The Community Outreach Programme hosted 250 events nationwide. A high point of Outreach was the Gallery project (supported by RDS) led by artist Emma Finucane, in which 12 special needs students from Enable Ireland/ Sandymount School produced a print (limited edition) on the theme of animals.

## EDUCATION OIDEACHAS

Education and Exhibitions saw a successful year of collaboration between the departments resulting in exhibition lecture series, worksheets, exhibition tours and teacher training.

Children's Summer Events were booked out and very successful. Family Activities, incorporating the Family Day, attracted 3,831 people. The Saturday Family Programme continues to be popular in the new format (limited to 70 adults/children).

Adult Education/Lifelong Learning; Art Studies and Drawing Studies are perennially popular, although the high point was the Great Master Series of 5 lectures attended by 700 people (detailed in the report).

Publications included *Effective Interpretation and Presentation*, No 5 in the Education Symposium Proceedings series (assisted by the Heritage Council), and *Learning From Art*.

The Child Protection Plan continues to be developed in line with national guidelines.

### 2 CHILDREN AND FAMILY ACTIVITIES



#### **The Family Programme (every Saturday at 3pm, except January, July, August & December)**

30 workshops were held from February to November the year coordinated by Frances Coghlan. Total attendance for the period was 2,420.

#### **Family Day (29 May)**

The annual Family Day comprised workshops led by Don Conroy, children's talks and music performed by Cór na nÓg and the Royal Irish Academy of Music. The Family Day Drawing competition was launched by RTÉ Den2 presenter, Frances Boylan Jr. launched by Damien McCaul from RTÉ Den 2, and music.

#### **Children's Summer Club (5-16 July)**

The Children's Summer Club was attended by 250 young people. The course included workshops for 'Little Masters', age 3-6years and 'Art Attack' for 7-12 year olds which explored themes of 'Travel via pictures in time and space' and 'Explore Gallery pictures'.

#### **Children's Sunday Talks (every Sunday at 12.30pm, April to September)**

26 half-hour talks and discussions took place during the year, with each session focusing on one painting from the collection.

#### **Christmas Family Art Holiday**

#### **(27-29 December)**

2004 celebrated the 40th anniversary of the Christmas Art Holiday. It comprised a series of family workshops (led by artists Clodagh Emo, Piia Rossi, and Don Conroy), talks in the 20th Century Irish Rooms and music in the Atrium. On the final day of the event, participants were invited to make a card to commemorate the Gallery's anniversary and about 200 cards were gathered from an audience of 350 people. These cards formed a representative sample of visitors to the Gallery on the day, from the UK, USA, Italy, France and counties around Ireland.

#### **The Story of the Great Masters (series of 5 lectures, October – November)**

To celebrate the Gallery's anniversary, a special art and supper lecture series took place over five weeks in October and November. Among the distinguished speakers who were invited to select and discuss a master painting from the permanent collection were: Sergio Benedetti (NGI) on Caravaggio, *The Taking of Christ*; Dr Manuela B. Mena Marques (Prado Museum) on Goya, *Doña Antonia Zarate*; Professor Ernst van de Wetering (RRP, University of Amsterdam) on Rembrandt, *Landscape with the Rest on the Flight into Egypt*; Dr Duncan Thompson (former Director, Scottish National Portrait Gallery) on Henry Raeburn, *Sir John and Lady Clerk of Penicuik*; and Professor Kenneth McConkey (Dean of School of Arts, University of Northumbria) on John Lavery, *The Artist's Studio*; *Lady Hazel Lavery with her daughter Alice and step-daughter, Eileen*. The lecture series was booked out in advance, and attracted an attendance of 700 people. Guests of the sponsors, Eagle Star, were given a private tour of each painting by the Head of Department.

#### **The 2004 Lecture: A Nation's Self-Image in an Art Museum (6 November)**

The most outstanding success of the Education Department's 2004 programme was the Anniversary Guest Lecture; 'A Nation's Self-Image in an Art Museum' by international art critic, historian and writer, Robert Hughes. Tickets for the talk sold out within days and took place in the Baroque Gallery attended by over 400 people. It was later broadcast by RTÉ Radio 1, on 31 December 2004

### 4 YOUNG PEOPLE'S ACTIVITIES & SCHOOLS PROGRAMME



#### Schools Programme

The Schools Programme continues to grow each year, offering a range of exciting ways to learn new skills and enhance student's knowledge of art.

#### Portfolio Preparations and Talks (25 September- 20 November)

Talks aimed to develop and enhance a student's understanding of the practice of making art. Topics included 'Visual Research: The Importance of Sketchbooks', 'Figure Drawing through the Ages' and a practical film-making workshop in association with the Irish Film Institute. This film workshop was a new departure which was in anticipation of the new Leaving Certificate Art History and Appreciation Curriculum which places a heavy emphasis on an expansion of the concept of the visual arts. Short drawing classes were held immediately after the talks which coincided with the theme of the day.

#### Portfolio Days

Two Portfolio afternoons were held in November which involved appraisal of existing portfolios, one to one advice for students, life drawing and visual research.

#### Gallery School Study Revision Day

A free study revision day took place on 27 November.

### Nationwide Study Revision Days

Following the success of the new Countrywide Revision Days in Cork, Athlone and Dundalk (full houses in each venue), more events will be scheduled next year.

### Tours

The tours section (detailed under the Public Programme) comprises school tours, exhibition tours, public tours, corporate tours, Personal Gift tours, disability tours, fee-paying tours (universities, summer schools, adult groups etc.).

### Exhibition Tours

The addition of exhibition tours is a recent one and has been highly successful, however, due to the fact that the exhibitions this year have had no direct links with the Leaving Certificate curriculum and that teachers would have to work hard to make them applicable, the number of people of school going age attending the exhibitions this year dropped dramatically.

#### *New Frontiers-art from new EU member states*

45 school tours of the New Frontiers exhibition were scheduled throughout the duration of the exhibition. Tours were free, and a worksheet accompanied the exhibition.

#### *Luis Meléndez-Still Lifes*

As this exhibition was showing during the summer months, no school groups were scheduled. Three came to see it in September before it closed.

#### *Learning From Art*

Demand outstripped supply for the special tour & workshop combination accompanying this exhibition with 60 sessions facilitated by Gallery tutors between 10 September and 10 October. A catalogue and worksheet accompanied the exhibition.

### Teacher Training

The aim of teacher training is to provide learning opportunities for teachers to find out more about art and the collection. Programme themes are adapted for all school levels, pre-primary-junior and senior cycle, and include Exploring Art at the National Gallery, Aspects of Irish Art, Creating New Art from Old Masters and exhibition themes. The number of sessions booked this year was low but consistent with the previous year. As schools tend to use their budgets to train their staff in new areas of the curriculum, this fall is most likely due to the introduction of curriculum changes in other areas. Funding for any In-service courses for teachers in the gallery was cut by the Department of Education and Science for the calendar year 2004. A total of 23 Teacher Training courses were held in the Gallery and four at Education Centres. A new option is for teachers to come to the Gallery, have a session on preparing their students for the museum visit, followed by a personal development session, where they have a relaxed visit with a guide to the area of their choice. Allowing this flexibility for teachers has worked well this year.

### 5 OUTREACH PROGRAMME

The Outreach Programme aims to create an awareness of, and interest in the collection of the National Gallery of Ireland. The work of the outreach service aims to communicate the collection in ways that are positive, enlivening and accessible to a wide range of groups within the community. The Outreach Service has a particular commitment to working with people with disabilities to make the national collection and the process of making art and looking and responding to artwork accessible to all. Over two hundred and fifty outreach events took place during the year in twenty counties around Ireland.

This year marked one hundred and fifty years of the foundation of the National Gallery of Ireland, and the exhibition *Learning from Art* signaled the involvement of young people in these celebrations. Launched in September, the project and its related activities received great interest within the Gallery and on its nationwide tour. In November, the

St. Josephs Ward houses two large collage works which were facilitated through the Gallery Education Service several years ago. It is now planned to work with the ward's current service users to create a new wall based art work and an artist has been selected for the project which is due to commence in early February 2005.
- The Outreach Service has also been approached to co-ordinate a project for The Ronald McDonald House, a new residential centre built on the grounds of Our Lady's Children's Hospital, Crumlin. Its purpose is to provide living quarters for the families of long stay clients of Our Lady's Hospital. It has been proposed that the students of the hospitals school create an art work for the house to enliven and enrich the visitor's experience of staying in the house. It is now planned to work with the schools current service users in 2005.

### Art Never Ages

During 2004, Art Never Ages events were provided in an outreach capacity in Cork, Cavan and West Meath including several active retired groups from County Offaly, who booked tours of the Gallery during the period of the festival. Education will build on the successful Art Never Ages programme next year.

## INTRODUCTION

The Gallery's research services offer a valuable service to staff and members of the public providing information and assistance to anyone researching the Gallery's collection and history, Irish art and related areas or art history in general. The year under review was extremely busy for the department, which incorporates the Gallery's Fine Art Library, the NGI Archive, the Centre for the Study of Irish Art and, provisionally, the Yeats Archive (since the retirement of the Yeats Curator in June 2004). Staff dealt with a total of 1866 research enquiries and 1260 people used the research facilities. Progress continued to be made, specifically in the areas of collection development, collating and providing access to the collections, developing digitization and preservation programmes and working co-operatively with other similar facilities and institutions. There were some staff changes during the year with Donal Maguire joining the department in February as the CSIA Assistant and Aoife Lyons, who had been on secondment in the Registrar's Department, returning to the library in September 2004.

The main focus for staff in 2004 was the initiation of a digitization project for the Gallery's archival collections. The prime purpose of the digitisation programme is to enhance access to archival and special collections held in the Library, NGI Archive, CSIA, Yeats Archive and Prints and Drawings collections. The long term objective is to make these collections available online through the Gallery's website. In addition to providing access, the digitisation project will also support the preservation of rare and fragile material by providing digital surrogates for researchers. A project team was established which included the Librarian, Archivist, Assistant Librarian, CSIA Administrator and CSIA Assistant, with project support provided by the Gallery's IT, Rights and Reproductions and Finance departments. The project addressed a number of issues, including developing a digitization policy and procedures, database and system requirements and copyright issues. Phase one

Rinneadh dul chun cinn leanúnach go sonrach sna réimsí bailiúcháin agus cóimheasa d'fhoinn teacht ar na bailiúcháin a éascú, ag forbairt ríomhchlár digitithe agus caomhnaithe agus ag obair le háiseanna agus le hinstiúidí den chineál céanna ar bhonn compháirtíochta. Tháinig roinnt athruithe ar an bhfoireann i rith na bliana; tháinig Dónal Maguire chuig an Roinn i mí na Feabhra mar Chúntóir CSIA agus d'fhill Aoife Lyons a bhí ina oibrí iasachta i Roinn an Chláraitheora ar an leabharlann i mí Mheán Fómhair 2004.

Ba le tionscadal digitithe le haghaidh bhailiúcháin chartlanna an Ghailearaí ba mhó a bhí an fhoireann gafa i 2004. Is í príomhaidhm an tionscadail dhigitithe go mbeadh teacht níos éasca ar bhailiúcháin speisialta agus cartlainne atá á choinneáil sa leabharlann .i. Cartlann NGI, CSIA, Cartlann Yeats agus bailiúcháin Priontaí agus Líniochtaí. Is í an aidhm fhadtéarmach go mbeadh fáil ar líne ar na bailiúcháin sin ag suíomh idirlín an Ghailearaí. De bhreis ar rochtain a sholáthar tabharfaidh an tionscadal digitithe tacáiocht do chaomhnú ábhair annaimh agus sobhriste trí ionadaithe digiteacha a chur ar fáil do lucht taighde. Ceapadh foireann don tionscadal lena n-áirítear an Leabharlannaí, Cartlannaí, Leabharlannaí Cúnta, Riarthóir CSIA agus Cúntóir CSIA, bhí tacáiocht maidir leis an tionscadal a sholáthar ag ranna TE Ceart agus Atáirgthe, agus Airgeadais an Ghailearaí. involved the procurement of a digital archive system. Specifications for the new system were drawn up and, having completed the tendering process, iBase Software Systems were commissioned to provide the new system in June 2004. The database provides access to the digital images and full catalogue records for the individual items. Useful additional and background information regarding the artists and collections is also presented. The system allows researchers to search for material using free text or more advanced searches if necessary. Work on a number of pilot projects was ongoing throughout 2004 and development of this system is well underway. It is expected that the new system, which will be called ARTseARCH, will be showcased as part of the Print Gallery exhibition devoted to William Orpen scheduled for May 2005.

Library staff have also been very active in developing links and working on cooperative projects with other institutions and cultural groups. The CSIA Administrator has been appointed to the editorial committee of the Strickland Centenary Project. The aim of the project is the publication of a comprehensive dictionary of Irish art and artists to mark the centenary of Walter Strickland's seminal *Dictionary of Irish Artists* of 1913. In October the Gallery was invited to join the working group of the Artists Paper Register's. The APR is a location register of the papers of artists, designers and craftspeople held in publicly accessible collections in the United Kingdom, and they are currently looking at extending the Register to cover papers of artists, designers and craftspeople held in Ireland. The Assistant Librarian was nominated for representation on the working group of Euro-Focus on the Cultural Heritage. The project focused on the creation of an online cultural portal [www.culturenet.ie](http://www.culturenet.ie). The portal will act as a gateway to Irish cultural resources online covering the entire cultural spectrum in Ireland (libraries, museums, archives, galleries, performance art, theatres, etc)

Osclóidh an suíomh tairsí isteach ar acmhainní cultúrtha Éireannacha ar líne a chlúdóidh speictream ionmlán an chultúir in Éirinn (leabharlanna, iarsmalanna, cartlanna, dánlanna, ealaín léirfheimíochta, amharclanna, 7rl.)

#### COLLECTION

This year the Library collection, which consists of monographs, journals, sales catalogues, exhibition catalogues, pamphlets and electronic resources, grew considerably. An additional 2386 titles were added and the collection now numbers approximately 40,000 volumes. Many donations were received and the Library acknowledges the generosity of Homan Potterton and Gwen Foster whose donations make very welcome additions to the collection. The Library now subscribes to approximately 70 academic and professional journals and continues to receive auction catalogues from all over the world. The Library continues to improve access to electronic information resources; the Library system, ArtCAT, was reconfigured to accommodate the library's rare books and special collections. In addition to the Bibliography of the History of Art and SCIPIO; Art and Rare Books Sales Catalog, the library now subscribes online to the Art Newspaper, the UK's Dictionary of National Biography and the Art Price Index which have all proven to be very useful to researchers. Work is also progressing on reducing the library's cataloguing backlog.

#### CENTRE FOR THE STUDY OF IRISH ART

The Centre for the Study of Irish Art (CSIA), which provides access to primary and secondary documentation on Irish art and artists, continued to develop in 2004. This year work focused on collating and cataloguing the collections of ephemera relating to Irish art. The CSIA welcomed many visitors, with the user demographic proving to be broad. Visitors have included research students, historians, collectors, practising artists, academic staff and private enthusiasts.

#### BAILIÚCHÁN

Tá an Leabharlann ag cur feabhas leis an teacht atá ar acmhainní eolais leictreonacha go seasta; Rinneadh athchóiriú ar chóras na Leabharlainne ArtCAT chun réiteach le leabhair uathúla agus le bailiúcháin speisialta na leabharlainne. Chomh maith le Leabharliosta Stair na hEalaíne agus SCIPIO; Catalóg Dhíolachán Ealaíne agus Leabhar Uathúil, iocann an leabharlann síntíús ar líneanois don Nuachtán Ealaíne, Foclóir Beathaisnéise Náisiúnta na Ríochta Aontaithe agus don Innéacs Praghás Ealaíne a bhfuil sé cruthaithe ina dtaoibh gur áiseanna anúsáideacha do lucht taighde iad. Tá obair ag dul ar aghaidh freisin i ndáil leis an gcarn atá fós le catalógúsa leabharlann a laghdú.

#### IONAD STAIDÉAR EALAÍNE NA HÉIREANN

Bhí an tIonad Staidéar Ealaíne na hÉireann (CSIA) a thugann deis do dhaointe teacht ar dhoiciméid phríomha agus tánaiste maidir le healaíon agus le healaíontóirí Éireannacha á chur chun cinn go seasta i 2004. Bhíothas dírithe i rith na bliana sin ar obair chóimheasa agus catalógaithe a dhéanamh ar na bailiúcháin de rudaí a bhaineann leis an ealaíon Éireannach ach nach bhfuil saol fada i ndán dóibh. D'fháiltigh CSIA roimh go leor cuairteoirí; dhealraigh sé to raibh déimeagrafach an úsáideora leathan. I measc na gcuairteoirí bhí mic léinn i mbun taighde, staraithe, bailitheoirí, ealaíontóirí gníomhach, baill foirne acadúla agus díograiseoirí príobháideacha.

NATIONAL GALLERY OF IRELAND  
ARCHIVE

The National Gallery of Ireland Archive which covers the history of the administration of the Gallery from the 1850s to the present day, was very busy in 2004. As well as researchers interested in the Gallery and its collection there has been a growing number of new students interested in the Millennium Wing as a research topic. The Archivist and library staff were also actively involved in preparations for the publication, *1854-2004 The Story of the National Gallery of Ireland*. Work involved the preparation of documentation for the author and researchers, sourcing suitable photographs and images for inclusion in the text as well as assisting in the editing process. Material from the collection was also selected and displayed in the Print Gallery exhibition 'A Plain Structure Firmly Built'-150 Years of the National Gallery of Ireland.

As well as dealing with the historic archives relating to the Gallery, the Archivist continues to gather current records from different departments within the Gallery and work has begun on developing a Records Management Programme. This project will be ongoing over the next two years and will involve all departments in the Gallery.

CARTLANN GHAILEARAÍ NÁISIÚNTA  
NA HÉIREANN

Roghnaíodh ábhar ón mbailiúchán freisin agus cuireadh ar taispeáint é i dtaispeántas an Ghailearaí Phríonta: 'A Plain Structure Firmly Built'-150 Years of the National Gallery of Ireland.

Chomh maith le bheith ag déileáil leis na cartlanna stáiriúla a bhaineann leis an nGhailearaí tá an Cartlannaí ag bailiú taifead reatha ar bhonn leanúnach ó ranna éagsúla laistigh den Ghailearaí agus tá obair tosaithe chun Clár Bainistiú Taifead a chur chun cinn. Beidh an tionscadal sin ag dul ar aghaidh ar feadh an dá bhliain atá amach romhainn agus beidh ranna uile an Ghailearaí gafa leis.

Chamber Choir

The Gallery undertook a number of key events to celebrate its sesquicentenary (1854–2004). A series of seven concerts, ‘*Ad Multos Annos*’ were organized in conjunction with the National Chamber Choir featuring specially commissioned works by international composers who were each invited to create an ‘*a cappella*’ piece inspired by a painting in the collection. Each performance was linked with the major schools of painting represented in the Gallery and included pieces by composers from the ten new EU member states. The concerts, which were recorded and broadcast by RTÉ Lyric FM, took place on Thursday evenings between the months of June and August and a gala concert featuring all of the commissioned pieces took place in September. A commemorative recording was made by the National Chamber Choir for CD and sold through the Gallery Shop.

A special commemorative report on the Gallery’s anniversary was published on 7 August in *The Irish Times*. The report proved very popular amongst Irish readers and resulted in the attendance of over 4,000 visitors at a specially organized programme of anniversary events in the Gallery on 10 August, which marked the anniversary date of the foundation of the institution.

Among the other anniversary events planned was the art and supper lecture series, *The Story of the Great Masters*, which comprised a series of five talks from October to November. The guest speakers, all prominent art historians from throughout Europe, spoke about their chosen masterpiece from the collection. Each talk was followed by supper in the Wintergarden, in the Millennium Wing.

As a culmination of the Gallery’s celebrations in 2004, internationally renowned critic and writer, Robert Hughes gave a seminal lecture on Saturday 6 November that focused on the relevance of old masters in the 21st century. That evening, Robert Hughes was guest speaker at the anniversary gala dinner attended by over 240 special guests which included Minister Mary Hanafin TD, benefactors, members of the Board and senior staff.

Bhí na coirmeacha cheoil ar thaifead agus ar chraol RTÉ Lyric FM iad ar siúl tráthnóna an Déardaoin le linn na míonna Meithimh agus Lúnasa agus bhí morchoirm cheoil inar léiriódh na píosaí coimisiúnaithe uile ar siúl i mí Mheán Fómhair. Rinne an Cór Aireagail Náisiúnta Taifead Comórtha le haghaidh dlúthdhiosca agus díoladh é i Siopa an Ghailearaí.

Foilsíodh tuairisc chomórtha speisialta san *Irish Times* an 7 Lúnasa i gcuimhne lá bunaithe an Ghailearaí. Ghlac léitheoirí Éireannacha go fonnmar leis an tuairisc agus is dá bharr na tuairisce a d’fhreastail 4,000 cuairteoir ar chlár imeachtaí sa Ghailearaí an 10 Lúnasa a bhí eagraithe go speisialta i gcuimhne an céad is a caoga bliana ón uair ar bunaíodh an institiúid.

I meascimeachtaí eile a bhí pleánálte i gcuimhne bhunú na hinstiúide bhí an tsraith léachtaí suipéir agus ealaíne, *The Story of the Great Masters* .i. sraith de chúig cainteanna a bhí ar siúl ó mhí Dheireadh Fómhair go dtí mí na Samhna. Labhair na haoichtain-teoirí, staraithe ealaíne mór le rá ó chuile cheard na hEorpach faoi na mórsaothair a bhí roghnaithe acu ón mbailiúchán. Tar éis gach caint bhí suipéar sa Wintergarden i Sciathán na Mílaoise.

Ag cur deireadh le ceiliúradh an Ghailearaí i 2004 thug Robert Hughes léacht bhisiúil ar an Satharn 6 Samhain a dhírigh ar an mbaint atá ag na seancháistrí leis an aonú céad is fiche. An tráthnóna sin bhí Robert Hughes ina aoi-chainteoir ag an dinnéar mór i gcuimhne bhunú an Ghailearaí ar a fhreastail níos mó ná 240 aíonna speisialta lena n-áirítear an tAire Mary Hanafin TD, bronntóirí, baill an Bhoird agus foireann shinseach.

## DEVELOPMENT FORBAIRT

One of the most innovative projects of the year was *RTÉ Moving Pictures* - a collaborative project between RTÉ and the National Gallery of Ireland. It aimed to celebrate the achievements of the Gallery over the years, however another mutual objective quickly emerged, to create something more innovative than the conventional coverage of anniversary events. For four weeks in November, the *RTÉ Moving Pictures* video booth, designed by the Office of Public Works, stood in the entrance foyer of the Gallery's Millennium Wing. By means of the striking fifteen-foot height façade of the booth, information posters and leaflets and a dedicated operating team, visitors to the Gallery were invited to step inside and contribute. People from all parts of Ireland as well as from Europe, the United States, Africa and Australia, recorded their comments and reminiscences, which have now been archived by RTÉ. The key broadcast feature of the project consisted of the programme, '*The View Presents...Moving Pictures*' transmitted on RTÉ Television on 21 December and watched by over 100,000 viewers. The programme – in keeping with the project's core values – emphatically placed the response of the public on the same footing as the views of artists, curators and professional commentators.

### Exhibitions

Sponsorship was secured for the major exhibitions in the Millennium Wing, details of which are listed in this report.

### Marketing Programme

The marketing programme during 2004 focussed on the temporary exhibitions and the permanent collection as well as highlighting the Gallery's sesquicentenary celebrations. Significant exposure through both editorial coverage and advertising was achieved right across the spectrum of media in Ireland and internationally.

### Corporate Events

Guided tours of the permanent collection and temporary exhibitions, followed by private receptions and dinners in the Gallery continue

RTÉ Lyric FM continue to record many of the musical performances at the Gallery for broadcast.
