Comment Card Box Design Competition – Frequently Asked Questions

How many entries can I submit?

Entry is limited to one portrait per student

Are there any size restrictions?

The work must be of a size and medium that does not inhibit its display in the NGI.

What does 'production-ready' mean?

Fully costed timeline with materials sourced.

What materials can I use?

Works in any media (including steel, plastic, glass and wood) are acceptable.

Where are the Comment Card boxes to be located?

The entry foyer of the Millennium Wing, the entry foyer of Merrion Square and the Atrium.

ENTRY PROCESS

Where do I find the entry form?

On the National Gallery of Ireland website: <u>www.nationalgallery.ie</u>

What will you do with my personal information?

All personal data given will be held securely by the Gallery and will only be used to administer your entry. It may be used for internal research/statistical purposes. It will not be passed to any third parties.

Can I send in my application by post?

No. All submissions must be made via email to: designcompetition@ngi.ie

How many digital photographs or renderings can I submit with my form?

You are restricted to submitting 5 images or renderings of your design.

What are the requirements for the images that I submit?

The image that you must be saved as a JPEG format. The file size must be no larger than 3MB.

COMPETITION TIMINGS

What is the closing date?

The closing date for submissions is 28 February 2018. No entries submitted after this date will be considered.

When does the judging happen?

The panel of judges will make their initial selection during March 2018.

How does the judging process work?

All the digital images/files of designs successfully entered will be viewed by a panel of judges. From these entries, the judges will draw up a shortlist for a second round of adjudication. From that shortlist to be adjudicated at the NGI in March 2018. They will then choose the winning design.

When will I hear if my design has been shortlisted for the competition?

You will be notified by email in mid-March 2018.

Will I be informed if I have not been shortlisted?

Yes. You will be informed by late-March 2018.
