PUBLIC PHOTOGRAPHY POLICY

- 1. The National Gallery of Ireland (NGI) permits still and video photography for personal, non-commercial use in the public galleries except in special exhibition areas or where specifically prohibited.
- 2. The policy is available to view/download online: https://www.nationalgallery.ie/what-we-do/governance/policies-and-reports
- 3. The policy is also displayed on public signage in the Gallery.
- 4. The use of flash, tripods, monopods or supplementary video lighting is not permitted in the exhibition areas.
- 5. The use of selfie sticks is prohibited.
- 6. Photography of general architectural features of the interior and exterior of the building is allowed.
- 7. Photography of works in copyright or on loan is not permitted where this symbol is clearly marked on display labels:



- 8. Enquiries and requests pertaining to reproduction of NGI works and/or those in copyright should be made to images&licensing@ngi.ie
- 9. It is possible to purchase high quality digital images of NGI works online/offline at www.nationalgalleryimages.ie
- 10. High quality reproductions of works from the collection in the form of postcards, cards and prints are on sale in the Gallery Shop in the Millennium Wing or online at https://shop.nationalgallery.ie
- 11. Members of the media who wish to photograph/film on the premises should contact press@ngi.ie
- 12. Commercial photographers and film crews who wish to photograph or film on the premises should contact images&licensing@ngi.ie
- 13. Students wishing to film on the premises should contact the Gallery's Education Dept: education@ngi.ie
- 14. From time to time, filming or photography is carried out in public areas of the Gallery. Should you wish to be excluded, please avoid any areas where camera crews/photographers are visible.
- 15. Permission to photograph or film material in storage is not permitted under the present circumstances.

- 16. Members of the public who are seriously undermining the enjoyment of others through use of cameras or any form of mobile device will be asked to cease photography by NGI security staff.
- 17. Should members of the public upload images shot in the NGI to online media sites, the NGI is free to use these images on its own websites should it desire to do so.
